

# Specialty Contractors Council Charter

## Purpose:

Provide access to specialty contractors by way of general contractors and service providers. This council is committed to helping our specialty contractor members grow in their business by opening a path for communication, relationships, and problem-solving.

## Committee Leadership:

The chair of the council serves for two years. The current council chair and steering committee elect a vice chair when the current vice chair moves into the chair position. Members of the Steering Committee may serve one year and may renew annually for up to five years. The chair of this council holds a seat on the chapter's Board of Directors and is expected to attend chapter board meetings. If they are unable to do so, the vice chair will attend.
