

Workforce and Professional Development Committee Charter

Purpose

The committee was created in 2009 to develop and carry out the workforce and professional development strategic objectives of the chapter. Committee appointees discuss and review the chapter’s needs to develop various education programs, recruitment efforts, and public relations and marketing messages that target the construction workforce. The committee also exercises budget and program oversight to chapter workforce initiatives.

Committee Leadership

The committee is led by the chair and vice chair for two-year terms, who are selected by committee members and who are confirmed annually by the chapter Board of Directors. The chair is appointed to board of directors.

7. Support AGC student chapters activities at OSU, OIT, and high schools across the region
